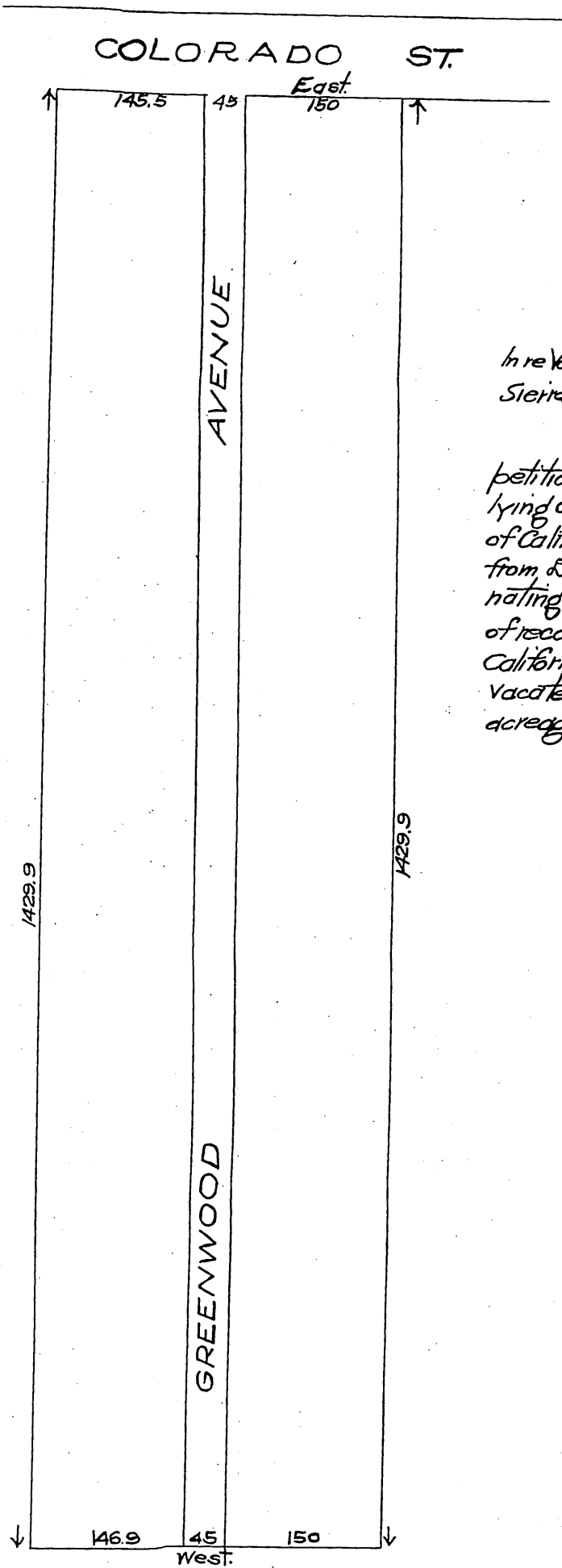
Boynton Tract

It is ordered that said petition be granted and that the following described public highway, situate, lying and being in the Sierra Madre Road District, County of Los Angeles, State of California to-wit: A certain street known as Greenwood Avenue, running South from East Colorado Street through what is known as the Boynton Tract and terminating at the South end of said Tract, as the same appears on a map thereof recorded in the office of the County Recorder of Los Angeles County, California, in Book 9 of Maps, at page 138, -- be and the same is hereby vacated and abandoned, and the land therein contained restored to acreage.
