ORIGIN AND PURPOSE OF THIS MAP

All descriptions of land parcels within the area of this map (the W % of the NE % of Section 9, Township 1 South, Range 10 West, S.B.M.) have been by metes and bounds. The original U.S. Government Survey upon which boundaries and land titles in this area are based was made in 1865 and is commonly known as the Hancock Survey. Measurements of this survey have since been found to be inaccurate in many respects.

In 1890, H.F. Stafford, Los Angeles County Surveyor, made a survey of a portion of the area in order to locate Puente and Azusa Bridge Road, which is now known as Irwindale Avenue. At that time he was unable to find any section monuments fixing the northwest and southwest quarter section corners. He, therefore, refixed these corners and set markers.

In 1909, I.B. Noble, Los Angeles County Surveyor, made a retracement survey of Puente and Asusa Bridge Road (now Irwindsie Avenue) and found that the quarter section corners had again disappeared. He again fixed the northwest and southwest corners of this quarter section. Of primary interest in the 1909 survey is the fact that it disclosed the existence of a number of possessory line fences extending easterly from Irwindale Avenue in the northeast quarter of Section 9. How these fence lines were established is not at all clear, but it is apparent that they were located and erected at some time between the 1890 and 1909 surveys. Most of these fences or other evidences of possession are in the same location today as they were in 1909. Almost none of these fences coincide with any paper title boundary lines and in some cases the discrepancies are as much as 80 feet.

Some of the metes and bounds descriptions in deeds and other instruments of title used the northwest corner of the quarter section as a starting point; some of them used the southwest corner of the quarter section as a starting point; in view of the inaccuracies of measurement in the Hancock Survey, this has led to some overlapping of paper titles and to the leaving of gaps in other instances.

The County Assessor has been attempting to assess the land on the basis of record title, notwithstanding the fact that record title lines are ambiguous and impossible of precise ascertainment. This has led to an unsatisfactory situation in which in some instances improvements assessed against one parcel of land may actually be situated on the adjacent parcel as its boundaries may be established by record title.

The true locations of boundary lines between parcels of land have been ambiguous, uncertain and impossible of ascertainment. As a result, errors have multiplied and confusion has increased. Among the serious results has been that it is well nigh impossible to procure bank loans on property in this area or to get policies of title insurance from reputable title companies, and this means that most of the parcels in this area are almost unmarketable for practical purposes.

These conditions led to a movement by the property owners, by the City of Irwindale, by the County Assessor, and others, to try to bring order out of chaos. It was the consensus of opinion of all interested persons that a possessory boundary line map of this area indicating the actual physical possession of the several parcels of land by the respective owners thereof and identification of, parcels by lot numbers, and an adjustment of titles so that each possessor should have record title to the land he occupied, would be the best solution. As a result, the area was carefully surveyed under the direction of E.T. Mankey, Deputy County Engineer, and the result is this map. The 77 parcels shown and numbered hereon are delineated in accordance with actual occupancy and not with any attempt to show the record title boundary lines.

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF IRWINDALE APPROVING A SUBDIVISION MAP OF A PORTION OF THE CITY OF IRWINDALE AND AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE RECORDATION OF SUCH MAP.

WHEREAS, the City of Irwindaie is currently engaged in a possessory boundary line project for the purpose of establishing and correcting the boundary lines to a portion of the land within such City, as hereinafter indicated; and

WHEREAS, a map has been prepared by the County Engineer of the County of Los Angeles which correctly sets forth and delineates the several parcels of real property, both municipally owned and privately owned, located within the area of such project; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the success of said project that said map be recorded in accordance with the provisions of Sections 11652 - 11658 of the Business and Professions Code of California;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

That said map, which has been prepared by the County Engineer of the County of Los Angeles, and which consists of three sheets bound together, and which is based upon, but is a modification of, County Surveyor's Map No. B-2760 duly filed in the Office of the County Engineer of said County, and which covers the area bound on the north by Arrow Highway and on the east by Ellen Drive, and which is a portion of the westerly one-half of the northeasterly quarter of Section 9, Township 1 South, Range 10 West, S.B.M., in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, be and the same hereby is approved as the official map of said portion of the City of Irwindale; and the City Manager of the City of Irwindale is hereby authorized and directed to cause the said map to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder of said County, pursuant to the Code sections cited above.

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


