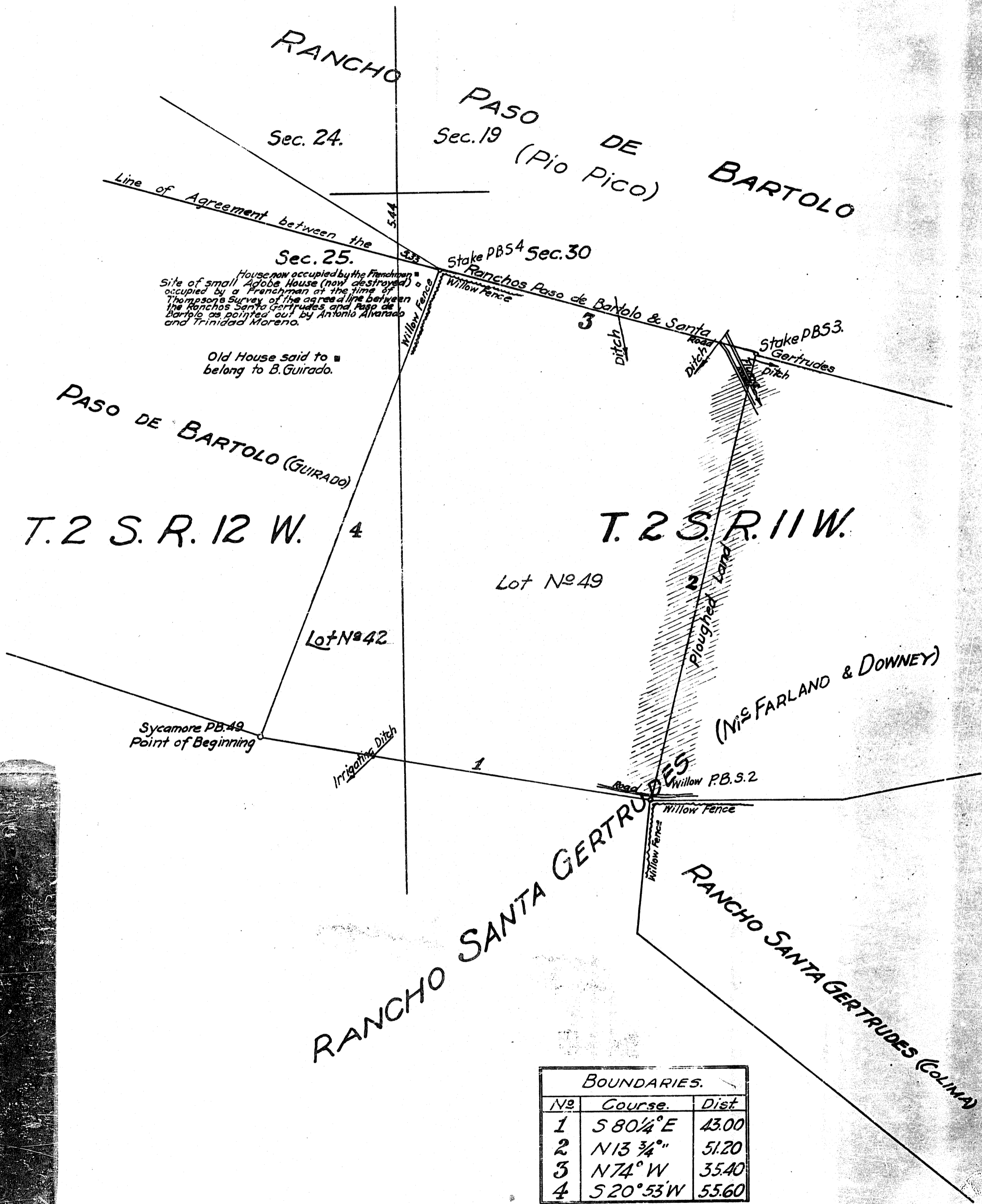


Plat of the Rancho
