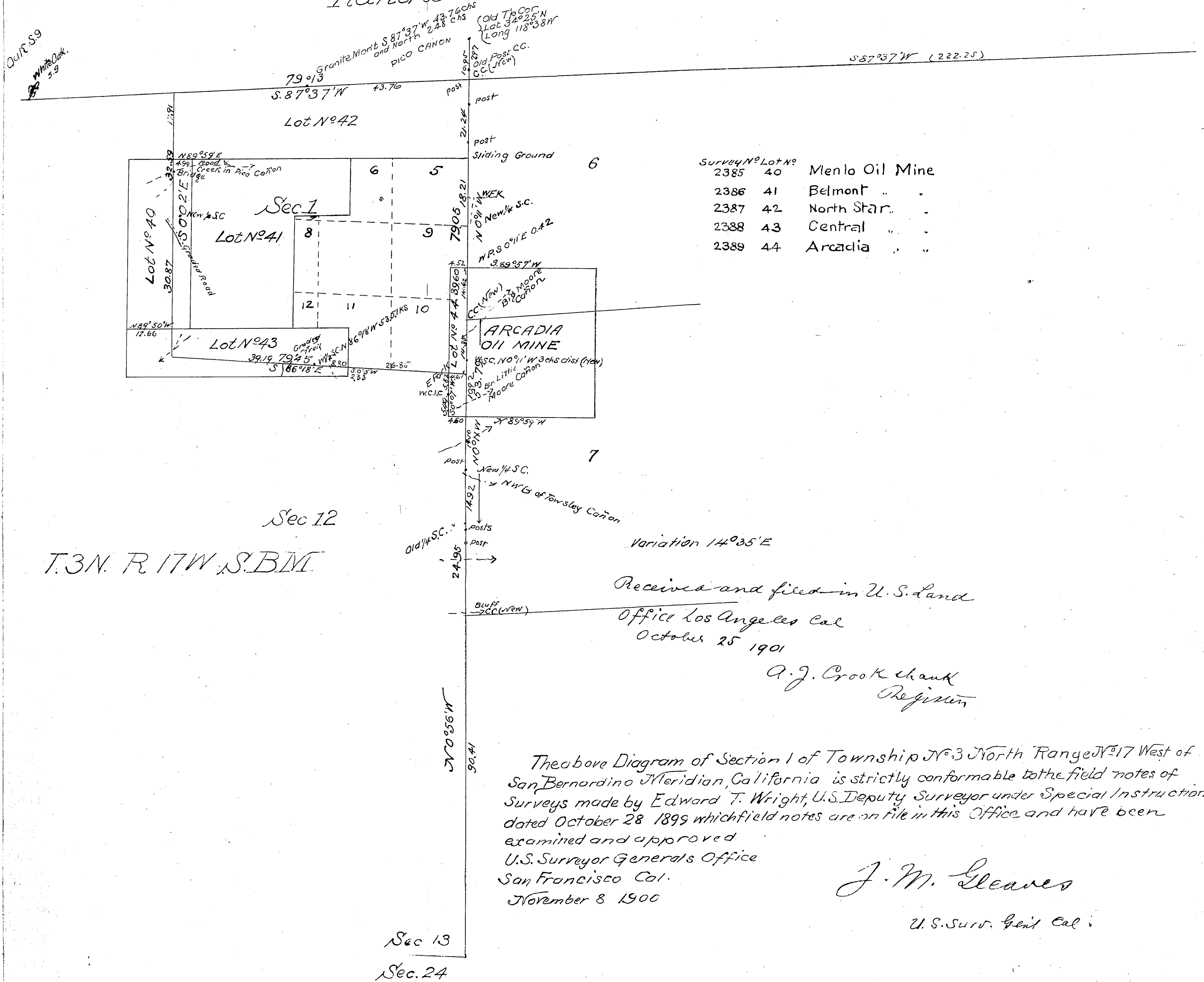

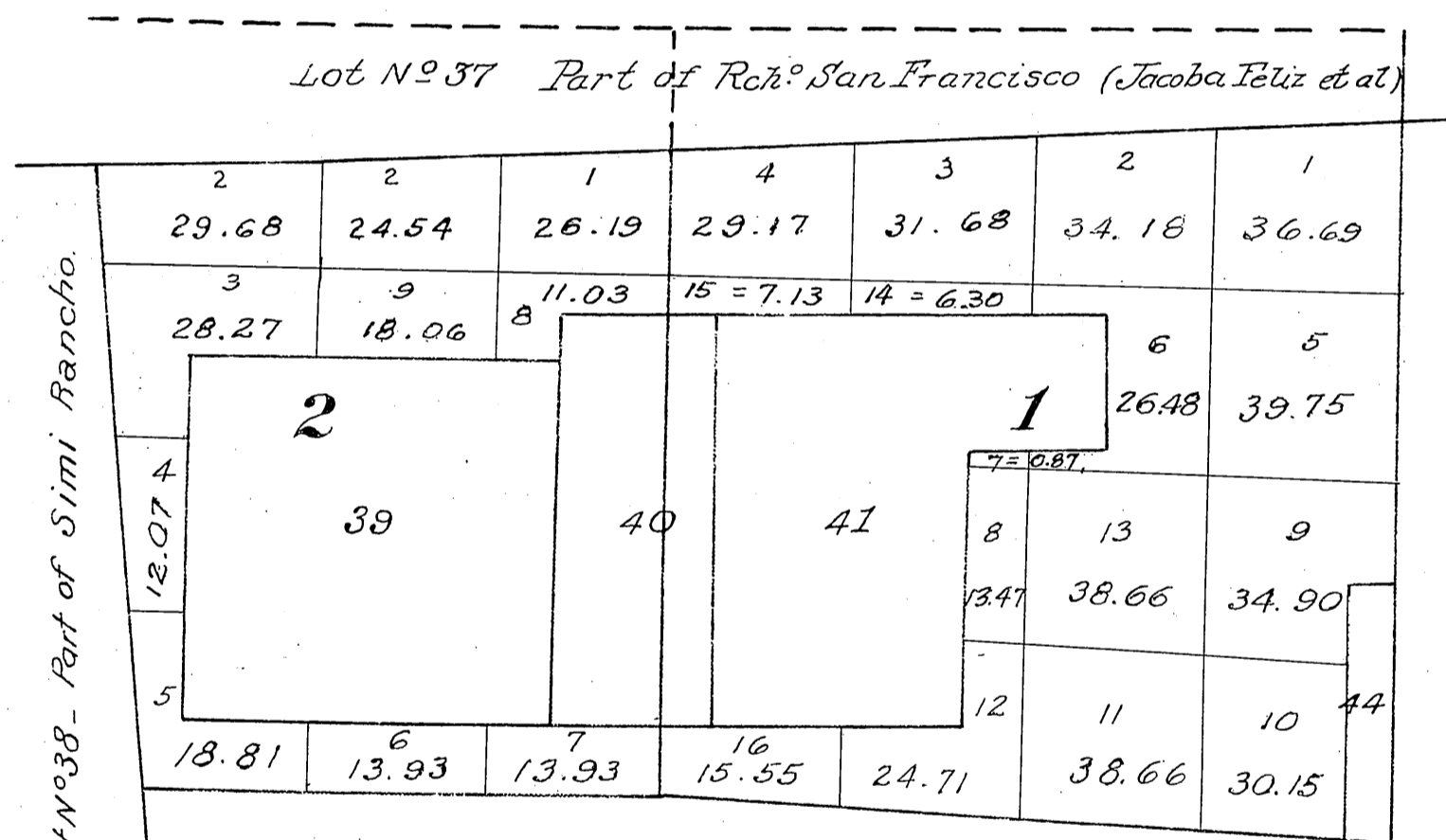

Lot N^o 38 - Part of Simi Rancho

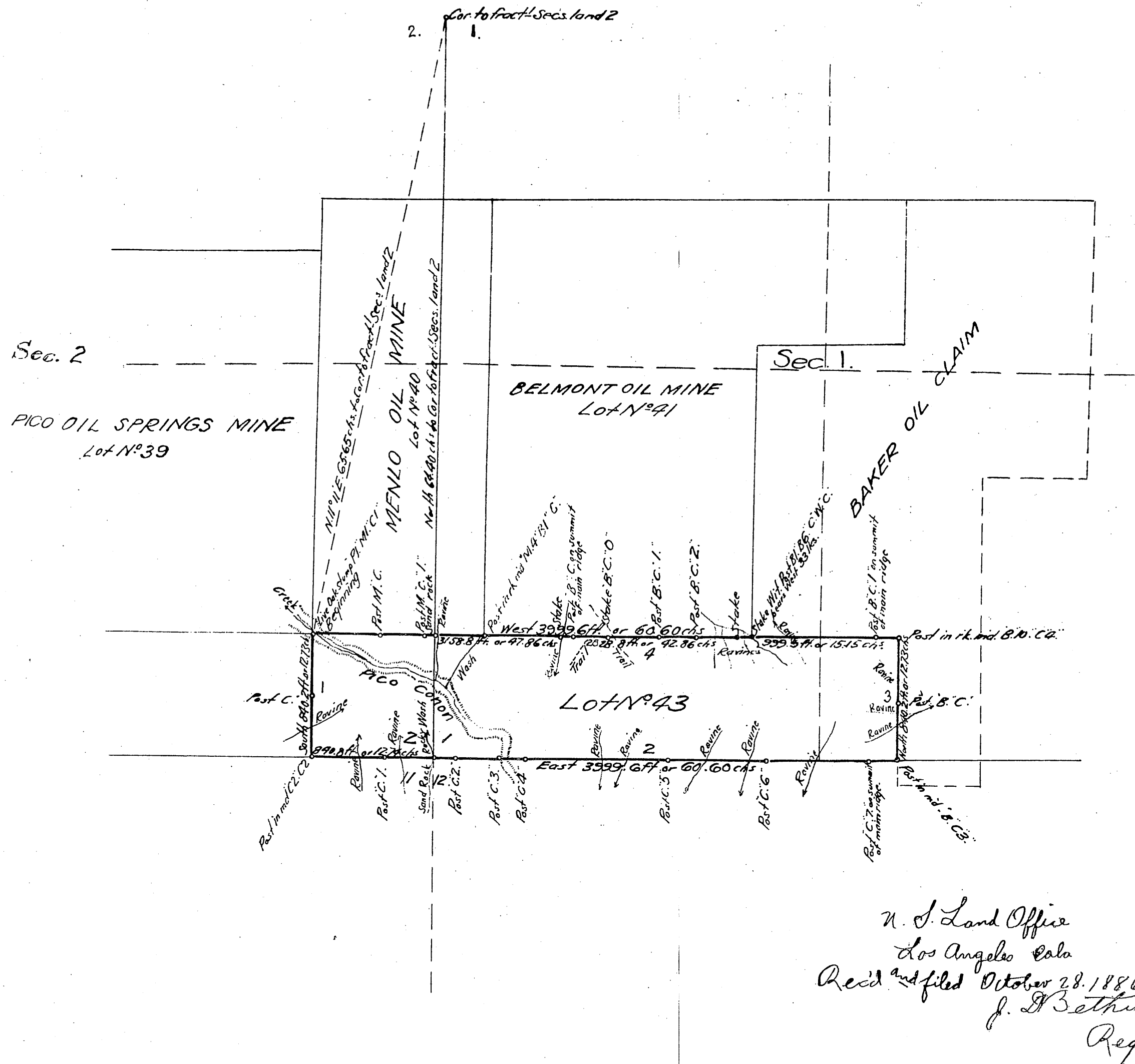
