

Los Angeles County Bicycle Master Plan Update

Overview

Los Angeles County Public Works (PW) is updating the Los Angeles County Bicycle Master Plan (BMP). The current BMP was last updated in 2012 and established a vision for the future of biking in the County. The BMP will serve as a guide for the development of safe and accessible bikeways and paths within unincorporated LA County and along County flood control district channels. The BMP will:

- Propose new bikeways
- Revisit the feasibility of unconstructed bikeways from the 2012 plan
- Incorporate new policies to share bikeway facilities with micro-mobility devices
- Identify first/last mile bikeway improvements to further connect to transit stations and bus stops
- Prepare for the Programmatic Environmental Impact Report

The County will engage with community members, community-based organizations (CBOs), and advisory committees to develop an inclusive and representative BMP. The BMP Update is anticipated to be finalized in late 2026.

Project Vision and Goals

Vision:

Make bicycling **safe**, **convenient**, and **accessible** for all ages and abilities in LA County.

Goals:



Safety. Prioritize bicycle projects that improve the safety of our streets.



Equity. Invest in underserved, pollutionburdened communities that are most dependent on active transportation.



Mobility. Increase the number of biking and multimodal trips.



Accountability. Be responsive, transparent, and accountable to our communities and regional partners.






Map of Unincorporated LA County
