



# Los Angeles County Bicycle Master Plan Update

Safe. Equitable. Planned for you.

## Overview

Los Angeles County Public Works (PW) is updating the Los Angeles County Bicycle Master Plan (BMP). The current BMP was last updated in 2012 and established a vision for the future of biking in the County. The BMP will serve as a guide for the development of safe and accessible bikeways and paths within unincorporated LA County and along County flood control district channels. The BMP will:

- Propose new bikeways
- Revisit the feasibility of unconstructed bikeways from the 2012 plan
- Incorporate new policies to share bikeway facilities with micro-mobility devices
- Identify first/last mile bikeway improvements to further connect to transit stations and bus stops
- Prepare for the Programmatic Environmental Impact Report

The project will engage with community members, community-based organizations (CBOs), and advisory committees to develop an inclusive and representative BMP. The BMP Update will be finalized in early 2025.

## Project Vision and Goals

### Vision:

Make bicycling **safe, convenient, and accessible** for all ages and abilities in LA County.

### Goals:



**Equity.** Invest in underserved, pollution-burdened communities that are most dependent on active transportation.



**Safety.** Prioritize bicycle projects that improve the safety of our streets.



**Mode Shift.** Increase the number of biking and multimodal trips.



**Transparency.** Be responsive, transparent, and accountable to our communities and regional partners.

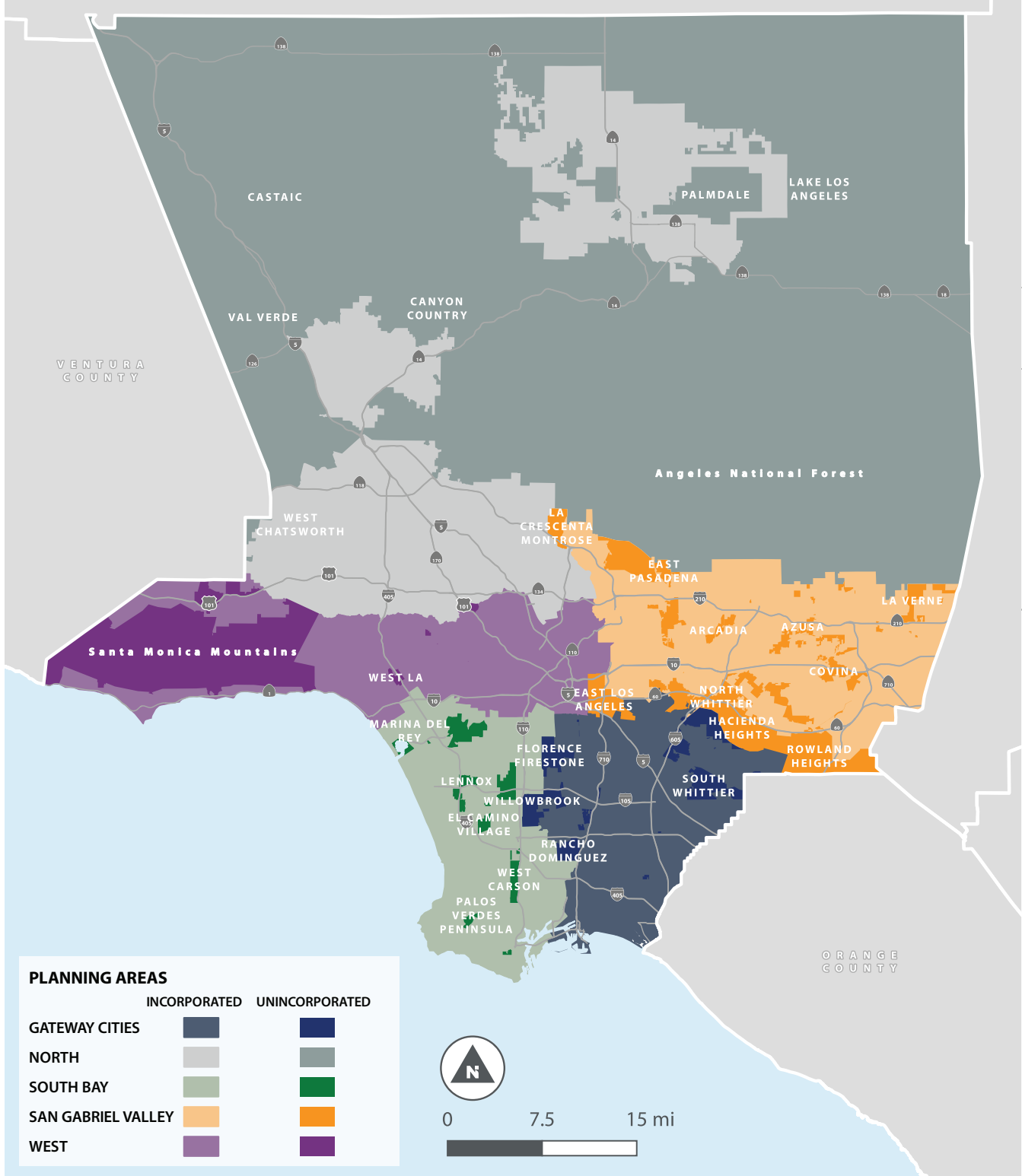
