Plan Background



- Planning area limits Foothill Boulevard between Lowell Avenue and Oak Grove Drive
- Planning efforts will cover approximately 6 miles along Foothill Boulevard
- Transform Foothill Boulevard into active transportation friendly corridor
- Planning partners Los Angeles County, City of Glendale, and City of La Cañada Flintridge



Active Transportation



- Active Transportation Use of human powered transportation modes
- Most common forms of active transportation are walking or biking
- Reduce reliance on motorized vehicles, increased mobility options, and reduce environmental pollutants







Sidewalks









High-visibility Crosswalks










