As defined in the *IRWM Grant Program Guidelines*, all urban water suppliers must provide the required documentation of compliance with AB 1420 (CWC §10631.5) and water meter implementation (CWC §525 *et seq.*), and all proponents whose projects have a potential groundwater impact must provide the GWMP self certification document (CWC §10753.7).
