



ALONDRA PARK MULTI-BENEFIT STORMWATER CAPTURE PROJECT UPDATE

Los Angeles County Public Works is pleased to announce the start of construction for the Alondra Park Multi-Benefit Stormwater Capture Project in the Unincorporated Los Angeles County community of El Camino Village. The project will enhance the existing Alondra Community Regional Park with construction of new stormwater infrastructure, soccer and multi-purpose fields, drought-tolerant landscaping, and renovation of two baseball fields. Construction is expected to be completed in early 2026.

Local access through the construction zone will be managed with temporary traffic control measures to ensure the safety of motorists and construction crews on Manhattan Beach Boulevard between Osage and Cranbrook Avenues. Traffic impacts can be expected from May to December 2024. During this time, at least one lane in each direction will remain open to vehicular traffic. Motorists are encouraged to plan trips accordingly, allowing for extra travel time or consider alternate routes if possible.

We appreciate your patience and understanding while we work to improve local water resilience and enhance recreational access. LA County Public Works will continue to update the community during the project.
