

The Project will construct a stormwater capture system at Adventure Park which includes a controlled diversion structure, a pretreatment unit, an underground reservoir, pump stations, and a filtration system. Captured runoff will be diverted into the sanitary sewer system underground. Above ground, park enhancements include a repaved parking lot, new drought-tolerant landscaping, replacement of exercise equipment, walking path restoration, an open seating area, a vegetated bioswale area, and interpretive signs to educate park visitors about the sustainable infrastructure.

The Project is currently in construction and is anticipated to be completed in late 2024.


