Rory M. Shaw Fencing and Landscaping Interim Improvements



The Rory M. Shaw Wetlands Park Project will convert a 46-acre former construction debris landfill into a world-class public park for Sun Valley. The site remains vacant as Los Angeles County continues to secure funding for this long-term project.

In the interim, Los Angeles County Public Works is taking steps to improve site security and enhance aesthetics for the surrounding community. Based on input from the community, this includes the installation of new 8-foot-tall tubular steel fencing as well as landscaping and irrigation along the site's perimeter and the eastern berm on Fair Avenue.

The landscaping and installation of the fencing will start in early 2025 and is anticipated to be completed within three to four months.
