

AV IRWM Plan Update

- **Basic IRWM Update** compliant with 2016 IRWM Plan Standards
 - Draft submitted in July
 - Documents uploaded to Office 365 OneDrive
 - Link shared with Stakeholders via e-mail
- **Full IRWM Update** reflective of the current conditions in the Region
 - Update pending



Fremont Basin IRWM – Boundary Modification


- Modification: include Fremont Valley GW Basin
 - Water supply source
 - MPUD
- 166 square mile overlap with AV IRWM
 - Population overlap ~4,400




Prop. 1 Implementation Grant PSP – Process

- **Phase 1 – Funding Area Pre-Application Workshops**
- Mandatory; February – July 2019
- DWR + State representatives + IRWM Region representatives
- 1-day workshop but can be > 2 days and/or multiple locations (based on geographical extent of Area)
 - Led by reps from each IRWM RWMG, applying entities, local project sponsor, DAC, EDAs, and Tribes (one person may represent more than one group)
- Work associated with workshop not eligible for reimbursement but is eligible as cost share toward project
- Provide platform for interregional coordination & increase potential for successfully completed projects
 - Present information on overall proposal and each project
- **Action Item:** Funding Areas to work together to select a date and location for workshop as well as Point of Contact (POC) to communicate with DWR by **February 1st latest**
 - POC – provide written verification of coordination with Regions & agreement on workshop details
 - Email at least 2 weeks before workshop; include Proposal Summary & Project Info Forms for each project (forms on DWR website)
- DWR to provide feedback within 4 weeks after workshop
- **Phase 2 – Final App Submittal**
- Funding Areas/Regions to submit complete app within 12 weeks of workshop (electronic submittal)
- IRWMs need to submit updated IRWM Plan compliant with 2016 Guidelines *prior* to applying
- Application checklist on page 16 of the PSP

Total Lahontan Funding Area Prop. 1 Allocation: \$24.5M. The Lahontan Funding Area has approximately \$18.8 million remaining for Implementation Round 1 and 2

Prop. 1 Implementation Grant PSP – Guidelines

Proposal Eligibility

- **Climate Change:** Proposal must include at least 1 project that directly responds to climate change by mitigating the potential impacts
- **Regional Self Reliance:** Overall proposal must help improve regional water self-reliance with one or more projects

Project Eligibility

1. Addresses “most” critical needs of IRWM region,
2. Is consistent with Statewide Priorities,
3. Has an expected useful life of 15 years, and
4. CEQA/permits will be completed within 6 months of funding award or prior to agreement execution, whichever occurs first
