

RESOLUTION NUMBER THREE OF THE BOARD OF THE LEONA VALLEY
GROUNDWATER SUSTAINABILITY AGENCY

STATE GRANT FUNDING

Resolved by the Leona Valley Groundwater Sustainability Agency, that application be made to the California Department of Water Resources to obtain a grant under the 2017 Sustainable Groundwater Planning Grant Program pursuant to the Water Quality, Supply, and Infrastructure Improvement Act of 2014 (Proposition 1) (Water Code Section 79700 et seq.), contingent upon approval of the County of Los Angeles' Board of Supervisors for matching funds to meet the 50 percent cost share requirement, and enter into an agreement to receive a grant for the: Fringe Area Antelope Valley Groundwater Sustainability Plan. Staff of the Los Angeles County Department of Public Works is hereby authorized and directed to prepare the necessary data, conduct investigations, file such application, and execute a grant agreement with California Department of Water Resources.

The foregoing Resolution was on the 1st day of November, 2017, adopted by the Board of the governing body of the Leona Valley Groundwater Sustainability Agency.
